Vignes Notre Dame



Located around Mont Brouilly and its pretty Chapel, the Brouilly cru is the most extensive of the Beaujolais vineyard. Spread over six municipalities, it is the southernmost cru of Beaujolais. This terroir is made up of granite scrambles which gives it a straight and pure structure on the palate.

Cultivated area: 1,328ha

Recognized AOP in 1938.

Average altitude: 290 meters



Intense purple red color.
Remarkable nose of black fruits (blackcurrant, blueberry) with good concentration and aromatic intensity.
Dense material on the palate held by precise and fine tannins releasing a nice balance in the end



Mature grapes harvested by hand
Limestone soil with granite stock
Manual pruning known as in a cup
Grape variety 100% black Gamay with white juice
